Check you know how to use conditionals for hypothetical situations

Talking about hypothetical situations, using 'if' sentences, use the 2nd and 3rd conditional, depending on whether you think the situation is possible or not. We often mix the 2nd and 3rd conditionals.

2nd conditional: if+past simple, would+infinitive (no 'to')

If it <u>rained</u> on the day of my party, I <u>would feel</u> really disappointed The possible future **3rd conditional:** if+past perfect, would have+past participle (verb 3)

If it <u>had rained</u> on the day of my party last year, it <u>would have ruined</u> the whole day The impossible!

If you <u>were married</u> with two small children, and you <u>had</u> a job with a good salary, but you <u>were</u> bored, <u>would</u> you <u>give</u> it up and take your family travelling round the world for a year?

Check you know how to indicate uncertainty

I couldn't say for sure,	but	I might	I used to think I'd but	now I think I'd
