Tom: if the verb ends with an <u>unvoiced</u> sound, the past simple verb ends with a /t/ sound

Dick: if the verb ends with a voiced sound, the past simple verb ends with a /d/ sound

Sid: if the verb ends with the sounds /t/ or /d/, the past simple verb ends with an /id/ sound
